#### **Admission Procedure:**

The admission is as per the guidelines issued by Govt. of Kerala, following mandatory reservation. Presently 50% of the seats (30 seats in each branch) are admitted by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations, Govt. of Kerala as per the rank list of Engineering Entrance Examination. Remaining 50% of the seats (30 seats in each branch) are Management / NRI seats.

#### (a). Minimum Marks for Admission:

UG: All candidates whether admitted through Central admission procedure (Govt.) or through Management or NRI quota should obtain 50% or more in Mathematics, and an average of 50% or more in Mathematics, Physics & Chemistry put together at plus two level.


